

PROCEEDINGS OF MICROTEACHING WORKSHOP FOR PGs (2019-20 BATCH) ON 27th May 2020

Microteaching workshop was conducted for PGs - MD/MS (2019-20 batch) of all the departments on 27-05-2020. 64-Post graduates attended the workshop. Dr. Vinutha Shankar M S welcomed MEU members and all the participants. She briefed about the importance of microteaching and stressed the use of specific learning objectives for teaching learning activities. She discussed the key teaching skills that can be learned by Micro teaching session using group activity and stressed the importance of structured student feedback.

Dr. T.N Suresh briefed about various teaching learning methods and also their advantages and disadvantages. He highlighted the importance of buzz session, group activity and flip class room for large group teaching through his interactive discussion. This was followed by session on Teaching Learning Media by Dr. Geetha S. She stressed on merits and demerits of oral communication, advantages and limitations of different T/L media. She highlighted the pros and cons of power point presentation/ blackboard teaching. Dr Swaroop Raj introduced the concept of using e-learning tools using tool such as mentimeter, kahoot, google forms, slides and pear deck in converting a didactic lecture to an interactive session during large group teaching. He also briefed on the online activities currently practiced in the university, which included our moodle based LMS platform and live lectures to students using Zoom Meeting which can be used for synchronous and asynchronous learning.

The participants were divided into 8-groups; each group had 8 to 9 PGs, 1 to 2 UGs and 1 to 3 UDOME faculty. The post graduates presented the topics for 8 minutes and feedback was given to them by UG students, other PGs (peers) and UDOME faculty.

This was followed by lunch. Post lunch session was debriefing by facilitators regarding the feedback on the presentation by post graduates which would benefit all the post graduates. This was followed by reteach session where the post graduates went back into their groups and represented the lesson plan for one presentation.



ORIENTATION DAY FOR I MBBS

The orientation day for the I MBBS students of SDUMC (2016-17 batch) was conducted on the 6th October 2016.

The program began with a guest lecture by Dr. Arvind Kasturi, Professor, Community Medicine, St. John's Medical College, Bengaluru. "Six suggestions for success in Health Professions" He gave six suggestions to succeed in the healthcare profession. He quoted relevant examples from history for his suggestions. Day 1 User orientation program started on 21.8.2015 at 8.45 a.m with first session by Dr. Sanikop, our beloved Principal on 'Introduction to mentorship program'. He emphasized on discipline and professional course. The role of mentor to facilitate mentee's development, learning and adjustment to build interpersonal relationship was elaborated. He analyzed the need of mentorship program in organization, designing goals, monitoring attendance, progress and strengthening parent teacher's interaction. The mentoring at departmental level with respect to discipline, progress in academics, co-curricular activities was very well defined. ended with the phrase "Beginning is half done, you wont win if you don't begin".

The second session was by Dr. R Ramaraj Urs, Director, Central library who spoke on library, learning resources and services extended. The Central library has good infrastructure with huge well designed state of art auditorium with 1100 members seating capacity. The digital library has seamless access to internet, printing and scanning facility, books, current periodical sections, UG sections with good seating capacity. The collection of sources of information and similar resources is made accessible for students and faculty for reference and borrowing supporting academic progress and standards. He focused on library holdings, digital library services offered and E-resources available in the library, reference services, open public access catalog (OPAC) and circulation of books

The third session was a brainstorming session by Dr. K N Venkateshwara Prasad, Professor & HOD, Dept. of pediatrics on 'Skills for learning'. He explained student's responsibility in learning, role of medical graduate as per MCI, learning strategies, study skills, learning tactics, note taking strategies and concentration strategies. He focused on surveying techniques, skimming, organizational techniques, reinforcement techniques, concept mapping technique, memory and test taking strategies. This will help the beginners to adopt these techniques for better development planning.

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This was followed by another talk by Dr. R Ramaraj Urs on Understanding of Journals .He provided information on scholarly journals, history of journals, free database availability, digital library services offered, computer assisted learning computer assisted instructions, internet browsing and downloads, HELINET, UGC SCHEME for needy students. He referred to the situation that in case of non-availability of any reference material interlibrary lending service is also available.

The last interactive session was delivered by Dr. Lakshmaiah, Professor, Department of Medicine on National Health scenario. The presentation sought to address basic health care services, rural health, control and eradication of communicable and non-communicable diseases, improvement of environmental sanitation, disease prevention, cure and rehabilitation. The programme started at 8.45 a.m, with first session on Time management and Study environment by Dr. Geetha. The students were asked what they would do if Rs.86,400 was deposited to their account everyday and they had to spend it all same day, to which the students readily answered number of ways they would spend the given amount. It was then revealed that it is the 86,400 seconds we have in a day and we have to spend every second in efficient and productive way. She explained that time management is optimum utilization of the time available. The need of time management was emphasized, which will make students more organized, meticulous, and efficient. Methods of time management by setting goals, preparing time frame, planning and prioritization were elaborated. Things to do daily were enlisted and categorized into vital, essential and desirable to do list. Two is to one thumb rule was explained which is to spend 2hrs of studying for every one hour of class. Students were told to make list of 5 time wasters and try to avoid them . The importance and the ways of time management was conveyed to the students .Talk was ended with the phrase-"Future is the result of what we do today"

The second session was by Dr.S.R.Prasad, who gave a brief outlook on Medical ethics. It was a very interactive session, where students were asked what Medical ethics is. Students very enthusiastically participated. Each word they answered was chalked down on the board and Sir described each of it. He explained medical ethics is doing right thing. It is the moral principles with values and judgement applied to the practice of medicine.

This was followed by third session at 10.15 a.m by Dr.Sudha Reddy on a very interesting topic –Communication skills. The role of Indian medical graduate was first defined, emphasizing the importance of communication skill. What is communication and the benefits of good communication was explained in detail. It was highlighted that communication is a core clinical skill and is required to practice high quality medicine. The types of communication which includes verbal, non-verbal and written were dealt with examples. Methods of improving communication skills, maintaing rapport with patients and methods of overcoming communication barrier were all discussed in a very effective way. Students were made to understand that communication is a core skill of questioning with active listening, and they can develop this skill only by practice.

Dr. Sridevi introduced cultural committee members, student council, and listed various programs conducted by the cultural committee. The duties and responsibilities of members of student council were explained. The students were encouraged to participate in the extra-curricular activities and to choose representative for the class, sports and culturals.

The last session was at 12 pm by DR. Muninarayan on National Health Scenario. He provided the overview of health status in India, social evils like poverty, illiteracy prevailing in India. He briefed upon the Indian health care sytem, human development index, and how to deliver health services to the rural population.

He also spoke on filing and reviewing the class notes within 24hrs of attending a lecture class to retain the information gained from the lecture class.

Medical ethics - Dr SR Prasad

Spoke on definition of medical ethics, how knowing ethics in medical practice benefits humanity, he also spoke on the principles of medical ethics, he stressed on the role of a medical professional in saving life, relieve suffering ,cure of patients disease, care Towards the patients, preventing disease, promoting general health in the public. Also discussed the principles of medical ethics by giving 2 case scenarios.

Learning skills and communication - Dr KNV Prasad

Spoke on what qualities make a good doctor in reference with a research conducted at mayoclinic, discussed the requirements for becoming doctor according to MCI guidelines, skills required to record a good history of the patient's disease in the process assessing the knowledge of the patient about his disease, capacity of the patient to make decision, physical and mental state examination, how to acquire skills to diagnose and manage, spoke on points to be remembered for developing effective communication with the patients and their attendants, considering difficult and violent patients, conveying the condition the patient is suffering from, skill to interpret findings on various grounds from history ,examination, lab investigations, skills to provide immediate care during medical emergencies, skills to prescribe drugs safely, he also spoke on skills to use information effectively in medical context, maintaining, storing and retrieving the medical records.

Biohazard safety - Dr. Arvind

He discussed the definition and classification of biohazardous materials generated in hospital including laboratory waste, spoke identifying symbols/labels and take necessary biosafety measures in the health care system, different levels of biohazardous waste according to CDC, segregation and safe disposal of biological waste materials according to rules and regulations established by the environmental protection act, he also spoke on transportation and shipping guidelines for biohazardous materials or samples.

NSS- national service scheme and YRC – youth red cross – Dr. Ananth and respective programme officers.

Dr. Ananth - gave brief introduction to the activity and its benefit to man kind.

First Session by Dr. Vinutha Shankar, Professor& HOD, Department. of Physiology, started at 8.45 A.M. Dr. Vinutha spoke on **How to Read Medical Text Book?** She briefed on how to read and remember effectively. Methods of making notes, techniques for enhancing memory by making mind mapping were also explained. Dr. Vinutha also spoke on scientific way of reading i.e. SQ3R (Survey, Question, Read, Recall, Review) technique. Various reading methods, how to improve reading skills? and to remember new terms was also stressed upon. She concluded the session by speaking on importance of organization in reading a medical text book.

Second session was by Dr. S.R.Prasad, Professor, Department of Microbiology. Dr. Prasad spoke on **Doctor-Patient relationship**. He spoke on the things needed and importance of building a healthy doctor-patient relationship. How a doctor can make patient believe or have faith in him which is very important for effective treatment was also told. Importance of medical professionalism, Hippocratic Oath, significance of registering the degree with the council, role of law and consumer protection act to prevent malpractice was also briefed by Dr. Prasad. He also explained the four models of Doctor-patient relationship which is very important in taking decisions. Dr. Prasad concluded the talk with a case scenario on medical ethics.

Third session by Dr. Sudha Reddy, Professor of Pediatrics was on the topic Communication Skills. Dr. Sudha started her lecture with a two minute video on doctor's attitude towards his patient. Fourth session was on Biohazard safety. **Dr. Aravind Natarajan**, Associate professor, Department of Microbiology spoke on the topic. After a quick recap on his previous day talk, various safety precautions or protective equipments used for biohazard accident were explained to students. Standard precautions- like use of gloves, masks, gowns, aprons, goggles and face shields- to be taken by health care workers from occupational exposure to blood borne pathogens was also explained in detail. Dr. Aravind also described the seven steps involved in hand washing. He also briefed on steps to be taken on accidental exposure to blood or body fluid. Finally, significance of vaccination and various decontamination methods was told.
